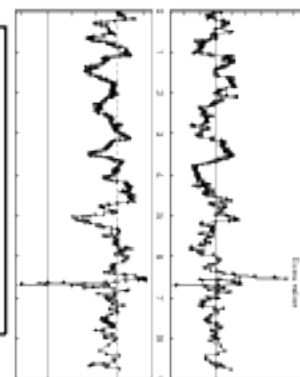
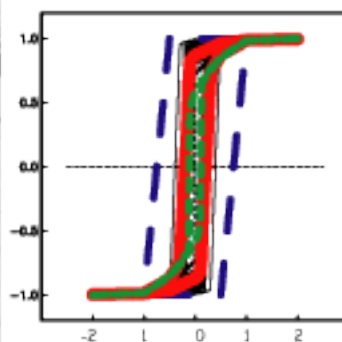
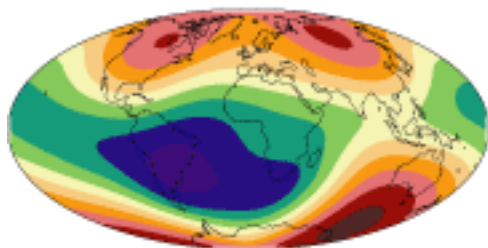


Rock and Paleomagnetism

This course will serve as an introduction to rock and paleomagnetism using the Lectures in Paleomagnetism course materials and software.
