The *Reviews of Geophysics* Search Committee seeks dynamic, well-organized scientists with high editorial standards and strong leadership skills to serve as Editor of the journal. The editorial term is 4 years.

Applicants should be respected leaders in the community, independent-minded, and even-handed. As Editor you should be committed to search the entire spectrum of the geophysical sciences for exciting topics of broad interest, to identify authors who can communicate their expertise in a stimulating, jargon-free style for the wider audience of *Reviews*, to work closely with authors to ensure the highest-quality presentations, and to oversee the review process. Editorial support for the review process is centralized at AGU headquarters

The editorial team, headed by the Editor-in-Chief, coordinates selection of topics to ensure broad and balanced coverage.

The Search Committee is appointed by the Union President to evaluate candidates and to conduct personal interviews with a small number of highly qualified individuals. The President makes the final selection and appointment. All AGU Editors serve at the pleasure of the President.
