CULTIVATING A CULTURE OF INCLUSION

Financial support from the AGU's travel grant programs increases opportunities for women, underrepresented minorities, and international students to attend Fall Meeting. In 2018, 59.3% of all grants were awarded to women, and 68.8% were awarded to international students. Of U.S. recipients, 43.1% were awarded to underrepresented groups. Travel grants help AGU accomplish its goals of advancing an equitable Earth and space science community.
