1. Visit the <u>journalism awards nomination system</u> home page. Before you can submit a nomination, you will need to login to the system by clicking the "Continue Log in" button on the left-hand side of the screen.

The Perlman and Sullivan awards each honor specific stories reported by journalists in the past year (i.e. 2021 awards honor 2020 stories). Journalists are welcome to nominate their own work for these awards, or someone may nominate a story on the reporter's behalf. Nominations may be from any country, in any language (English translation required), and in any news medium, except books. Eligible news stories must be about one or more of the scientific disciplines represented by AGU. A nominee may submit only one entry for each award in a given year (i.e. one entry for the Perlman and one entry for the Sullivan). Each award consists of a plaque and a \$5,000 award.




6. When you have completed the nomination form, you can "Save" the nomination to come back to later, or "Save and Finalize" to submit the nomination.
