

Call for Applications:

Early Career Editorial Fellows (2026–2028) for *JGR Biogeosciences*

We invite applications for the second cohort of Early Career Editorial Fellows (ECEF) for *JGR Biogeosciences*. This program provides early-career researchers with hands-on experience in scholarly publishing and editorial processes while working closely with the journal's editorial team.

ECEFs will gain insight into manuscript evaluation, editorial decision-making, publishing ethics, and broader issues in scholarly publications. Fellows will have opportunities to interact with Editors, Associate Editors, reviewers, and authors, helping to develop skills that will support future leadership roles in scientific publishing. The expected time commitment averages approximately 2–4 hours per month. Fellows will participate in periodic meetings with the editorial team, observe and discuss editorial decision-making processes, participate in peer-review, and contribute to special projects. The program is designed to provide meaningful editorial experience while remaining compatible with the demands of an active research career.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be within five years of receiving their Ph.D. as of August 1, 2026.
- Have a demonstrated interest in scholarly publishing and peer review.
- Be actively engaged in biogeosciences research relevant to the journal's scope.

Fellowship Term

The fellowship term will run from August 1, 2026, through December 31, 2028.

Application Materials

Applicants should submit a single document (**maximum one page**) that includes:

- Educational and professional background
- Current position and institution
- Relevant professional or research experience
- A list of published manuscripts
- Peer-review experience, if any
- A brief description of why you would like to serve as an Early Career Editorial Fellow and what you hope to gain from the experience.
