#### Leadership

## Program and project advice

- Ensure that AGU keeps a balanced range of titles that reflect diverse scientific fields.
- Look for topic gaps in AGU's books portfolio.
- Identify prospective book editors and authors.
- With support of AGU staff and our publishing partners, communicate advantages of choosing AGU for a book project to prospective book editors and authors.
- Participate in discussions about new types of books in response to changing trends in publishing, education and science.

### **Editorial oversight**

- Review new book proposals; alongside AGU staff, assess their quality and suitability for AGU's portfolio.
- Provide editorial oversight for 1–2 books in preparation at a time, ensuring that AGU publishes high-quality content.
- · Periodically meet with book editors and authors.
- Intervene in cases that have unusual conditions and help guide decision-making.
- Monitor the peer review process for quality, impartiality, etc.

The Editorial Board position includes honoraria for proposal and book assessments, waived registration to the AGU Annual Meeting and full digital access to AGU journals.

Editorial Board Members are expected to adhere to the Ethical Obligations of Editors and Code of Conduct outlined in AGU's Scientific Integrity and Professional Ethics Policy.
